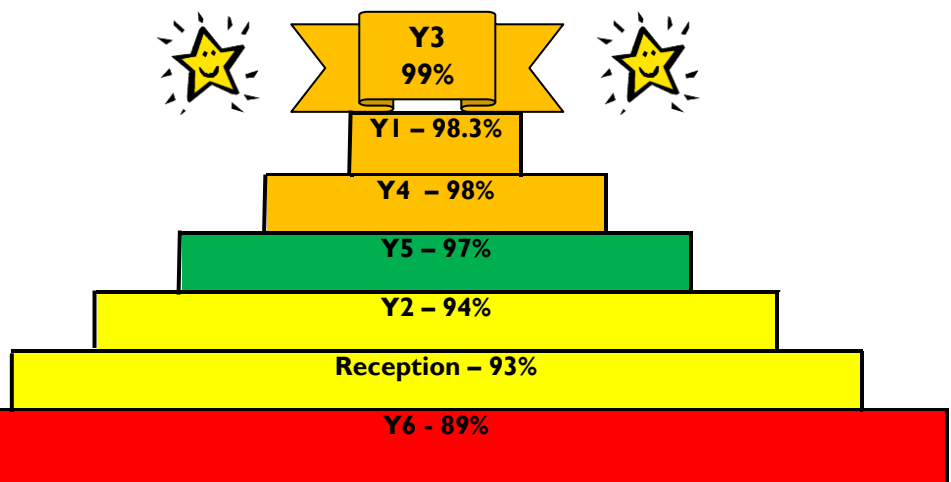

Christmas 2021 Information

Thank you to our families for following our guidance and congratulations to the winners of our chocolate Christmas hampers. Don't forget individual photographs of your child in their costume have been uploaded to Tapestry (Reception) and Seesaw (Y1&2).
- Mrs Burnham and the school council thank our school community for the generous donations made to the Salvation Army Christmas Toy Appeal. Mrs Burnham will be taking the donations to the Salvation Army this week.
- Our KS2 Carol Concerts take place at church next week on Tuesday 14th December and Wednesday 14th December at 2.15pm. Information has been sent home via letter this week about this event. We ask that adults take an LFT with a negative result before attending Church and wear a face covering unless medically exempt. Do **not** attend if you are feeling unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms.
